

DISTRICT PROFILE

ABOUT US:

District Institute of Education and Training (DIET), Udalguri was established in 2023 as per the provision of National Policy of Education 1986 and became functional w.e.f. 1st April, 2024. Since its inception, this DIET has been serving for the upliftment of School Education scenario under Udalguri district. It has been playing an important role in implementing different programmes of Government of Assam, Samagra Sikhsa, Assam. The DIET has been continuously providing academic support to the schools, research and studies, teacher training program, extending support to school education department of the district and the State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT), and development and orientation of Textbook.

OUR MISSION:

Our mission is to provide a support and create a conducive learning environment for teachers to uplift the educational scenario of Udalguri district. Our aim is to upgrade both the academic & non-academic fields by taking up holistic approach to increase the enrolment rate of the students and minimising the dropout rate that has been a prevailing issue of the district.

OUR VISION:

1. The vision of the DIET is to work vigorously for the betterment of the teachers and students of both Elementary and Secondary Schools of Udalguri District.
2. In the light of NEP-2020, DIET also envision to be at the upper strata of the developmental ladder in terms of performance.
3. To ensure quality education in the district by providing academic support to teachers according to their needs, promoting research and innovation.
4. DIET also envisioned to be a learning hub for the teachers in the district in terms of performance.
5. The Vision of DIET (District Institute of Education and Training) is to serve as a centre of excellence in the field of elementary education and teacher training, aligned with the NEP 2020 goals and local educational needs.
6. To build a vibrant and inclusive learning ecosystem that empowers teachers, supports innovation in classroom practices, integrates local resources, and ensures equitable and quality education for all children in the district.
7. Offer continuous learning and capacity-building opportunities for teachers and educational leaders.

DISTRICT LOCATION:

Udalguri district is located in the Northern part of Assam adjoining the foothills of Bhutan and Arunachal Pradesh. The Headquarter of the district is at Udalguri and it is located in the distance of 126 KM from the state capital, Dispur. The district lies between 26°44' N latitude and 92°05' E longitude.

LOCATION OF DIET:

The DIET is situated on the way of Tamulpur-Tezpur road at Ambagoan under Odalguri Tehsil in Udalguri district which is 9 KM towards the west from the district headquarter Udalguri. The geographical location of the DIET is 26.7405° N longitudes and 92.0254° E latitudes.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND:

Etymologically the name Udalguri has been derived from ‘Odal Trees’, which means a place surrounded by the Odal trees. Another opinion regarding the origination of the name of the district believes that it has originated from the hermitage named Uddalak Muni. According to another opinion it came from the BODO word ONDLA + GUNDRI which means powdered object.

ABOUT THE DISTRICT:

Udalguri, a district in Assam shares an international border with Bhutan and also a state border with Arunachal Pradesh at its north, Sonitpur district to the East, Darrang district to South and Baksa District to the West.

On 14th June, 2004 the district was carved out from Darrang district as one of the five districts under Bodoland Territorial Council.

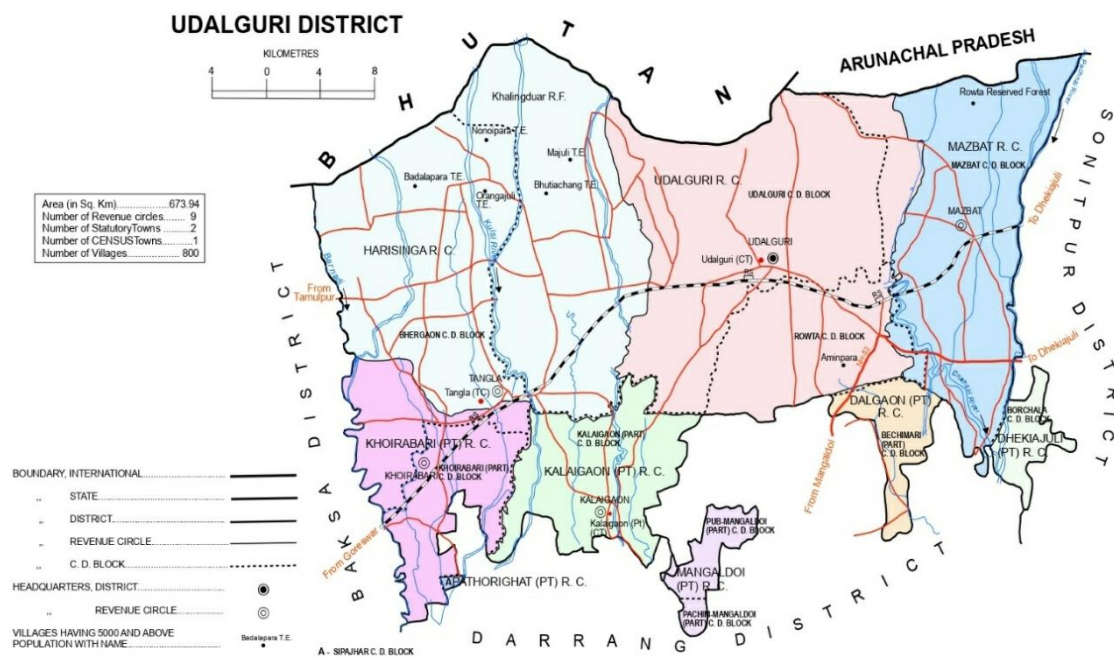


Fig: Udalguri district map (copied from district forest department website)

ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS:

Udalguri district consists of two subdivisions namely Udalguri and Bhergaon which are further divided into 5 revenue circles- Udalguri, Mazbat, Harisingar, Kalaigaon and Khoirabari.

There are four Vidhan Sabha constituencies in Udalguri district which are Tangla, Bhergaon, Mazbat and Udalguri (ST). These are the part of Darrang-Udalguri Lok Sabha Constituency.

RELIGION:

People from different religions reside over this district, it is the multi-ethnic and multi religious in nature. 73.64% of the population are Hindus, which is the largest group in the district followed by Christians and Muslims with the percentage 13.25 and 12.66 respectively.

The largest ethnic group of the district is the Bodo with 31.76% of the district's entire population. Other significant ethnic groups are Adivasi, Nepali, Gorkha, Assamese, Bengali, Rabha etc.

LANGUAGES:

Udalguri is a multi-lingual district. There are various languages spoken by the people of the district. According to 2011 census, 26.90% of the population speaks Bodo, 22.62% speaks Assamese, 19.43%

speaks Bengali, 7.88% speaks Sadri, 5.60 speaks Nepali, 2.79% speaks Santhali, 2.64% speaks Uria, 2.08 speaks Kuruh, 1.66% speaks Hindi, 1.57% speaks Mundari & 1.45% Bhujpuri as their first language.

DEMOGRAPHY:

Udalguri district has a population of 8,31,668 (male-421617, Female-410051). According to 2011 Census with population density of 413 per sq km. The geographical area of this district is 10985.68 sq Km. the major inhabitants of the district are Bodo, Assamese, Nepali, Bengali, Uria, Santhali and General Tribes. The child sex ratio of the district is 973.

LIVELIHOOD:

Agriculture is the cornerstone of Udalguri's economy, contributing significantly to household incomes. It is the main livelihood of the people of the district where 80% of the total workforces depend on agriculture, mainly tea garden wage workers. Rabi and Kharif are the two principal crops of this district. Besides this, a small portion of workforce is engaged in livestock success piggery, fishery etc and as daily waged labourer.

CULTURAL HERITAGE:

Udalguri district boasts a rich cultural heritage for its diverse ethnic communities and historical sites. Various tribes of this district with unique traditions, festivals and customs enriched the beauty of its culture. It is also noteworthy to mention that the district has historical and religious sites like Bhairabkunda, Mahamoni Devalinga, Sri Sri Bashudeva Mandir, old Baptist Christian Church etc.

The district is the home to various types of festivals, including Bihu, Bathou Puja and other community specific festivals.

LITERACY RATE:

According to 2011 census the total literacy rate of Udalguri district is 65.41%. The male literacy rate is 72.58% and female literacy rate is 58.05%.
